Joanna,

I am sending the O.P. out today to all partner ministries for comments . I have asked for comments by December 12th (not sure if this will work, but I'll give it a try!).

At this time, I think the best way to deal with this is through our standard "One Window" process. Once I have received the comments and compiled them for the Township (and County) I would like to meet with the Township to go over them. I agree with you that it may be beneficial to ask for a meeting with Council to explain these comments at some point -- this may be particularly important with regard to the alvar.

Speaking of the alvar, it seems from talking with my colleagues that our office has never worked on an Official Plan that has a specific policy to highlight the importance of an alvar. However, that doesn't mean that we shouldn't consider it for McNab Braeside. I would ask that you start to think about the type of "special policy" that MNR/MMAH would like to recommend to the Township -- would it, for example, be similar to a policy to protect an ANSI? You may want to discuss this with Dennis Lemore or Greg Pulham, but if this particular alvar is as unique as you have described to me, I think we should try to protect it.
