Hi Stuart,

Based upon a brief discussion of the 'Ontario Parks Planning and Research Work Planning' process during our recent Natural Heritage Forum telecom, I have prepared two proposals for Pembroke District. It is my opinion that both myself and the District are in a better position to deliver on these items than we were several years ago. I have provided a brief description of each proposal for your consideration and use in including these in a regional submission as per the guidelines.

i) Preparation of Life Science Site District Report for 6E-16 (former 5E-12)

A site District report has never been prepared for this site district and such a report would fill a significant gap in the coverage of site region 6. This site district is the northern extent of the main agricultural zone of southern Ontario extending along the Ottawa River in an area formerly covered by the Champlain Sea. Although primarily agricultural, this landscape includes numerous natural areas influenced by a diversity of physiographic and geologic features. This site district is also expected to come under significant development pressures in the foreseeable future associated with extension of Hwy 417.

Justification: This work is consistent with Southcentral Region Natural Heritage Strategy, Pembroke District Natural Heritage Strategy, as well as provincial guiding documents. The proposal is also consistent with the number one ranked priority as recently identified by the Southern Region ANSI Task Team.

Request: \$15.0k B-salary, plus EB, and \$5.0k ODOE

ii) Braeside Alvar Inventory and Assessment : Undertake a service contract with an experienced botanist to inventory, map, and assess the Braeside Alvar feature. It is expected that this site will become recognized as being of provincial significance. Results could become an important component of a site specific ANSI Confirmation Report. Priority task based upon; i) interested partners, ii) known extensive areas of alvar which are to my knowledge only scantily inventoried, iii) opportunities to purchase select alvar properties with partners at bargain prices, iv) currently no protected alvar sites in 6E-16, v) probable new ELC alvar communities, vi) opportunities to use information for municipal planning protection.

Request: \$16.0k ODOE
