Hi Eleanor,

I am not aware of a comprehensive list for the entire Braeside Alvar (aka Sand Point Alvar).

However, the following significant flora species are known to occur at the Braeside Alvar:

Provincially Significant

Ram's-head Orchid (*Cypridpedium arietinum*) S3/G3 Cooper's milk-vetch (*Astragalus neglectus*) S3 Giant Pinedrops (*Pterospora andromedea*) S2

Regionally Significant

Amelanchier alnifolia var. *compacta*
Bromus kalmii
Carex richardsonii
Diphasiastrum complanatum
Juncus articulatus
Panicum flexile
Panicum philadelphicum
Scutellaria parvula
Solidago asteroides
Trichostema brachiatum
Veronica peregrine
Sporobolus heterolepis

There is very good potential for other significant flora to be found with additional field work.
