My conversation was brief with Ms. Norma Moore of Braeside area during her call of 29th March 2006.

She was expressing interest and concern in the natural heritage features of the Braeside Alvar area with respect to development proposals, specifically a quarry expansion and proposed asphalt plant.

Ms. Moore informed me that she has been communicating with local naturalist club members and many other concerned local citizens, and that she has acquired a copy of the Ontario Nature (formerly FON) document on the Alvars of Ontario.

She asked whether I have reviewed any environmental reports on the quarry expansion, which I indicated that I have not seen anything although a consultant asked me general questions about the alvar feature a year ago. I suggested she talk to you Keltie for information about the process and at what stage this particular application might be. I gave her your email and phone number.

I suggested she should talk to MOE about her concerns with respect to the aquifer (quantity and quality) and air pollution.

I confirmed MNR's interest in the alvar feature and values, and that we are currently working with the local municipality to include it as Significant Wildlife Habitat (as per PPS) in their ongoing efforts of preparing an Official Plan.
